SINGLE PHASE EFFICIENCY CURVES









THREE PHASE EFFICIENCY CURVES












Three-phase Short Circuit Decrement Curve. No-load Excitation at Rated Speed Based on star (wye) connection.







OUTLINE DIMENSIONS FOR 41 THRU 62 KW OPEN GEN-SET









OUTLINE DIMENSIONS FOR 41 THRU 62 KW LEVEL 2 ENCLOSURE (HINGED DOORS)






